## Did You Know?

The Earth's axis is tilted 23.5°. Because of this tilt, as the Earth revolves around the sun, the rays from the sun are concentrated on different parts of the Earth. During the summer, the sun's rays are directed more in the northern hemisphere of the earth. During the winter, the sun's rays are directed more towards the southern hemisphere.

During its revolution of the sun, there is a time when the tilt of the northern hemisphere reaches its closest incline to the sun. This is called the Summer Solstice. This becomes the longest day of the year for the northern hemisphere. This usually happens between June 20th and June 22nd. This year, it happens on June 21st at 4:51am. Most calendars will use the summer solstice as the beginning of summer.

## Product Spotlight—Flowsleeve

The most common cause of premature pump failure is inadequate water flow around the pump. In cases where pumps are put in well casing, the casing helps direct the flow of water past the motor to keep it cool. In other cases, where the well casing is too large or the pump is used in a tank, pond or cistern, water needs to be directed to flow past the motor to keep it cool. Enter Flowsleeve.

Previously, Delco Western had made sleeves for pumps using pipe and Fernco couplings. Flowsleeve has created a product that is better suited to a make-shift sleeve. Designed to accommodate a variety of pump sizes and discharge sizes, Flowsleeve is the product to use. 4" sleeve kits have discharge sizes of 1", 1-1/4", 1-1/2" and 2". 8" kits come with 4" discharge sizes with 3" and 6" discharges coming soon.



Newly designed from Flowsleeve is the 4" pump stand for horizontal pump installations. Using one to lift the discharge side up or two for a true horizontal application, this provides for stability and gets the suction away from the soil, silt and debris.
